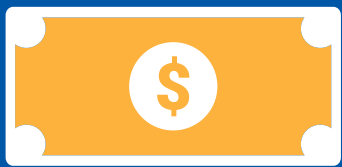

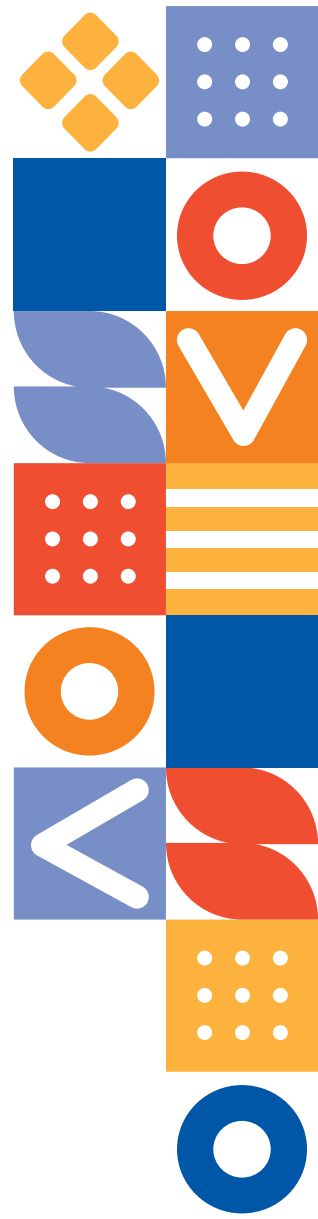

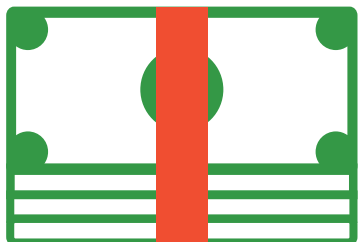
FROM DONATION TO IMPACT

VITA offers free tax return preparation and electronic filing with IRS-certified volunteers. In-person and virtual services are available for low- to moderate-income Racine County residents.
