8:00 a.m. – A student meets with a mental health therapist at their school, helping them navigate difficult situations.

5:30 p.m. – A family prepares dinner with items from a local food pantry, allowing the family to stretch its budget.

6:30 p.m. – A family attends a literacy and parenting program where children improve literacy skills and parents work to learn conflict management skills.

8:00 p.m. – A father calls Impact 211 after being recently laid off, seeking housing support. 10:00 a.m. – Parents meet with a financial coach who helps them build credit and create a budget, lowering stress and anxiety.

4:30 p.m. – Students go to an after-school program to get help with their homework, explore college and career paths and set goals for their futures.

1:30 p.m. – A second-grader becomes a more confident reader as they read aloud with a Schools of Hope volunteer.

> 3:00 p.m. – At a Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) site, a working family receives help filing their taxes and qualifies for the Earned Income Tax Credit.
